## ***Hunting for Beautiful Minds* - Call for the award of a partial scholarship (50%) for deserving female students for admission to the Day School of H-International School S.r.l.**

### **1. Subject and purpose**

1.1 Through this call, named “Hunting for Beautiful Minds” (hereinafter the “Call”), **H-International School S.r.l.**, with registered office at Via A. Olivetti 1, 31056 Roncade (TV), Tax Code and VAT no. 03888620261 (hereinafter “H-IS”), establishes the procedures for the award of no. 1 partial scholarship for deserving female students wishing to enrol in the High School path of H-FARM International School, starting from MYP4 (Grade 9, equivalent to the first year of upper secondary school), with effect from the academic year following the publication of the Call.

1.2 The scholarship is intended to support the complete academic path of the selected student within the Middle Years Programme (“**MYP**”) and Diploma Programme (“**DP**”) delivered by H-IS and recognised by the International Baccalaureate Organization (“**IB**”), from MYP4 through completion of the DP2 programme.

1.3 The MYP and DP programmes constitute an internationally recognised path of educational excellence, designed to provide solid and interdisciplinary academic preparation and to facilitate access for students to the leading national and international universities.

1.4 The scholarship is made possible thanks to the generous funding of a private supporter, and is intended to facilitate access to a high-level international educational pathway for motivated and deserving female students.

1.5 This Call pursues the objective of promoting the development of young female students with a strong aptitude for international education and with interests in the fields of innovation, entrepreneurship, technology and creativity.

### **2. Scholarship value and duration**

2.1 The scholarship covers 50% of the annual *tuition fee* and *registration fee* applied by H-IS for the Day School (day school, without boarding), as determined on the basis of the School’s fee schedule in force for each relevant academic year, and as updated from year to year in accordance with the School’s pricing policies. It is specified that, for each academic year following the first, any increase in the scholarship amount compared to the previous year shall not in any case exceed 4% (four per cent). It is therefore understood that any increases in the fees applied by the School which result in a 50% increase exceeding such percentage shall remain at the expense of the student’s family for the portion exceeding the aforementioned 4% limit.

2.2 The benefit takes effect from admission to MYP4 (Grade 9, equivalent to the first year of upper secondary school) and may be maintained, subject to the academic and behavioural requirements set out in this Call, for the entire duration of the High School path, until completion of the DP2 programme (Grade 12), structured as follows:

- **MYP4 (Grade 9)** – first year of upper secondary school;
- **MYP5 (Grade 10)** – second year of upper secondary school;

- **DP1 (Grade 11)** – third year of upper secondary school;
- **DP2 (Grade 12)** – fourth and final year of upper secondary school.

2.3 All costs relating to ancillary or supplementary services are expressly excluded from the scholarship coverage, including, by way of example and not limitation, the school transport service (School Bus), extracurricular sports activities (*After School Sports*), school trips, textbooks and any other service or cost not expressly indicated as covered by the scholarship.

2.4 The scholarship cannot be combined with other financial benefits, scholarships or fee reductions granted by H-IS or by third parties.

### **3. Eligibility requirements**

Applications under this Call may only be submitted by candidates who, by the deadline for the submission of applications, meet all of the following requirements:

- a) female gender and date of birth between 1 January 2011 and 31 December 2012;
- b) residence in one of the following Provinces: Treviso, Venezia, Padova or Udine;
- c) achievement, in the previous academic year, of a school grade average equal to or higher than 8/10;
- d) successful completion of the final examination of the first cycle of education for the purpose of admission to upper secondary school; this qualification must be obtained no later than 5 July 2026;
- e) valid Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) not exceeding euro 40,000.00;
- f) level of English language proficiency between B1 and B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR);
- g) absence, at the date of application and for the entire duration of the benefit, of other scholarships or financial benefits incompatible with the scholarship covered by this Call;
- h) submission of the application complete with all the documentation required by this Call, within the deadlines and in the manner provided herein.

### **4. Application procedures and mandatory documentation**

4.1 The application under this Call must be submitted exclusively by completing the dedicated online form prepared by H-IS.

4.2 The following documentation must be attached to the application, on pain of exclusion:

- a) copy of the last two available school report cards;
- b) motivational video;
- c) any reference letters issued by teachers, tutors or other relevant educational figures;
- d) project work, consisting of a presentation of up to 10 slides or a text of up to 4,000 characters including spaces, aimed at proposing an idea or initiative designed to influence a behaviour or dynamic of the candidate's own generation;

- e) documentation proving the income situation, for the purposes of verifying the ISEE requirement;
- f) certification attesting the candidate's level of English language proficiency equivalent to B1 or B2;
- g) copy of a valid identity document of the candidate and of the parents or legal guardians.

4.3 The absence, incompleteness or non-conformity of the requested documentation shall result in exclusion from the selection procedure.

## 5. Evaluation Committee

5.1 The evaluation of applications is entrusted to an Evaluation Committee, appointed by H-IS, composed of:

- a) a representative of the H for Human Foundation;
- b) the Head of School or their delegate;
- c) the Head of Admission;
- d) the donor or their delegate;
- e) the Head of MYP programme or their delegate.

5.2 The Committee operates with full decision-making autonomy; the assessments and judgements expressed are an expression of technical discretion.

## 6. Selection criteria and procedures

6.1 The selection of applications shall take place on the basis of the following criteria, for an overall maximum score of 100 points:

- a) academic performance: up to a maximum of 30 points;
- b) project work: up to a maximum of 40 points;
- c) motivational video: up to a maximum of 30 points.

6.2 The first five (5) candidates placed in the preliminary ranking shall be summoned to take an English language test and a mathematics test, aimed at defining the final ranking.

6.3 H-IS shall notify candidates admitted to the final tests, by email, of the date, procedures and content of the tests with at least five (5) days' notice.

6.4 The final tests in English and mathematics serve a purely selective function and do not entail the awarding of additional points. The outcome of the tests is used by the Committee for the purpose of confirming, modifying or excluding candidates from the preliminary ranking, based on an overall assessment of the profile.

## 7. Procedure timeline

7.1 The award procedure is structured according to the following calendar:

- **Deadline for submission of applications: 15 March;**

- **Evaluation Committee proceedings:** from 19 to 23 March;
- **Publication of the preliminary ranking:** 27 March;
- **Final tests:** by 9 April;
- **Publication of the final ranking:** 15 April;
- **Deadline for acceptance of the scholarship:** within five (5) working days of the official communication of the award;
- **Deadline for confirmation of enrolment:** within five (5) working days of acceptance of the scholarship.

7.2 The dates indicated may be subject to change due to unforeseen organisational requirements; any variations will be communicated by publication on the official H-IS website.

## **8. Application submission and grounds for exclusion**

8.1 The application must be submitted no later than the strict deadline of **28 February**, exclusively through the online form available on the H-IS website.

8.2 Incomplete applications, applications not in compliance with the provisions of this Call or lacking, even partially, the required documentation, shall be automatically excluded, with no possibility of integration or remedy after the submission deadline.

8.3 H-IS assumes no liability for any delays, disruptions, technical malfunctions or errors attributable to third parties, IT systems or causes of force majeure.

8.4 In the event of withdrawal by the awarded student, the scholarship shall be assigned to the next eligible candidate suitably placed in the ranking among those deemed eligible and not awarded.

## **9. Beneficiary obligations and grounds for forfeiture**

9.1 The beneficiary student is required to:

- a) maintain adequate academic performance and conduct compliant with the internal regulations of H-IS;
- b) regularly attend the educational activities provided for in the school path;
- c) cooperate, where requested, in institutional initiatives, communication activities or events linked to the scholarship programme.

9.2 The scholarship shall lapse automatically in the event of:

- a) loss of merit requirements or seriously inadequate behaviour;
- b) false, inaccurate or incomplete declarations made at the time of application or thereafter;
- c) withdrawal from studies or transfer to another school;
- d) failure to comply with the deadlines for acceptance of the scholarship or for confirmation of enrolment.

9.3 In the event of forfeiture, the portion of the scholarship not yet used shall not be disbursed and the student's family shall be required to pay the remaining school fees in full.



## **10. Maintenance criteria and annual renewal of the Scholarship**

10.1 The scholarship, although awarded for the entire school cycle from MYP4 through completion of DP2, is subject to annual review by the Evaluation Committee or by a sub-committee specifically delegated for this purpose.

10.2 Maintenance of the financial benefit is subject to the joint fulfilment of the following requirements:

- a) maintenance of an annual school average not lower than [7/10], with no serious failing grades in any of the core subjects of the IB curriculum (including English, Mathematics, Science, Individuals and Societies);
- b) level of commitment, participation and conduct compliant with the internal regulations of H-IS;
- c) regular attendance of educational activities, except for absences justified in accordance with school regulations;
- d) maintenance of the family's financial situation, verified through the submission of an updated ISEE not exceeding euro 40,000.00, save for reasoned and substantiated assessments by the Committee;
- e) participation, if requested, in institutional activities, testimonial initiatives or projects connected to the scholarship programme.

10.3 The award and maintenance of the scholarship are incompatible with the imposition of serious disciplinary sanctions pursuant to the internal regulations of H-IS.

10.4 The verification for the purposes of scholarship renewal is carried out annually by 31 July; the outcome is formally communicated to the family within the deadlines provided for by the enrolment calendar.

10.5 In the event of failure to meet the minimum requirements, the Committee may at its discretion:

- a) revoke the scholarship for the following academic year;
- b) alternatively, grant a monitoring period until the first term of the new academic year, at the end of which the final decision shall be made.

10.6 The Committee reserves the right to assess exceptional circumstances duly documented, such as health reasons, extraordinary family situations or events occurring during the academic year.

10.7 Failure to renew the benefit does not entitle the recipient to appeal or review procedures, subject to any internal assessments granted exclusively at the discretion of H-IS.

## **11. Reservation of modification and liability**

11.1 H-IS reserves the right to modify, suspend or revoke, in whole or in part, this Call due to supervening organisational, financial or regulatory needs.

11.2 Under no circumstances shall H-IS be held liable for delays, disruptions or events arising from causes beyond its control.

## **12. Publication of the outcomes**

12.1 The preliminary and final rankings shall be communicated to the candidates and their respective families in the manner and within the timeframes set out in Article 7.

12.2 No review or appeal procedures are provided for against the decisions taken by the Evaluation Committee.

### **13. Award of the scholarship and collection mandate**

13.1 The scholarship is awarded by H-IS through official communication to the awarded student and her family, following approval of the final ranking.

13.2 The financial benefit deriving from the award of the scholarship to the Student is applied as a partial reduction of the school fees due for attendance at the Day School, within the limits and in accordance with the procedures set out in this Call.

13.3 By accepting the scholarship, the parents or holders of parental responsibility grant H-IS a specific **collection mandate**, authorising it to retain and allocate directly, as a scholarship, the sums made available by the programme's supporter as partial coverage of the school fees due by the Student.

### **14. Final provisions**

14.1 The award, maintenance and possible revocation of the scholarship take place in accordance with the criteria and procedures set out in this Call; the assessments carried out by the competent bodies of the School are an expression of technical discretion and are not subject to review, except as otherwise provided for by law.

14.2 Participation in this Call entails the full and unconditional acceptance of all the provisions contained therein. Participation in the procedure and possible placement in the ranking do not give rise to any right to the award of the scholarship, which is deemed conferred exclusively through the formal communication referred to in Article 13.

14.3 For matters not expressly governed by this Call, the following shall apply:

- the internal provisions and regulations of H-IS, in force from time to time;
- the national legislation in force on education and training;
- the provisions of the Italian Civil Code compatible with the nature of the relationship established.

14.4 This Call constitutes the sole regulatory source for the scholarship award procedure. Any communications, clarifications or informational materials shall not prevail over nor supplement the provisions of the Call.

14.5 The scholarships awarded under this Call are subject to the tax regime provided for by the legislation in force.

### **15. Personal Data Processing**

15.1 The personal data provided by candidates and their families as part of the selection procedure shall be processed by H-IS, in its capacity as Data Controller, exclusively for purposes connected with the management of this Call and with the possible award, management and maintenance of the

scholarship.

15.2 Data processing shall comply with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR), Italian Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, as amended by Legislative Decree no. 101/2018, as well as with applicable national and EU legislation.

15.3 Data shall be processed in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, minimisation and security, and shall be retained for the time strictly necessary to pursue the purposes for which they were collected, save for legal obligations.

## **16. Applicable law and jurisdiction**

This Call is governed by Italian law. For any dispute relating to its interpretation or application, the Court of Milan shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
